Application for *Nina Otero-Warren* Institutional Grant
2010

Institutional grants of the Historical Society of New Mexico honor the contributions of Nina Otero-Warren, author, educator, and political activist who led in the effort to secure voting rights for women in New Mexico. They are intended to assist organizations or institutions in completing projects consistent with the purposes of the Society, e.g. development and dissemination of historical information and fostering of interest in the history of New Mexico and the Southwest. The maximum grant is \$500.00. Grantees must be dues-paid organizational members of the Historical Society of New Mexico for the year in which the grant is made. Applications are accepted through May 31, 2010, and applicants should be advised of the status of the application not later than July 15, 2010. Projects, or the portion for which the individual grant is requested, should be completed between August 1, 2009 and July 31, 2011, though a later completion date is permissible. Payment of the grant is made upon approval of the Board of the Historical Society of New Mexico and the return of a signed grant agreement to HSNM. Upon completion of the work, the grantee will provide a brief report of expenditures (receipts not required) and accomplishments. Articles and/or presentations based on completed projects are not required but are welcome and may be considered for publication in the Society's *La Crónica de Nuevo México*. **Review of applications will begin after May 31, 2010.**
