



# The Myra Ellen Jenkins Award

## Eligibility:

Applicants for the Myra Ellen Jenkins Award must be conducting research toward a graduate degree at an accredited college or university. Applicants for this award must be either New Mexico citizens enrolled in a graduate program in any accredited college or university or any student enrolled in a graduate program at an accredited college or university in New Mexico.

**Amount of Award:** \$1,000.00

## Requirements for Award:

1. Complete 80 hours of research;
2. Write a short research report;
3. Write a 3-10 page essay related to the fellow's research topic which will be published on the Office of the State Historian's website [www.newmexicohistory.org](http://www.newmexicohistory.org) and submitted for publication in the Historical Society's *La Cronica*;
4. Awardees are encouraged to give a public lecture on the topic of their research at an annual New Mexico History Conference sponsored by the Historical Society of New Mexico.

The fellowship check will be presented at the annual New Mexico History Conference.
