John Conron started the chronicle of the Historical Society of New Mexico, *La Crónica de Nuevo México*, in 1976. Pedro Ribera-Ortega suggested the name. There is not a fixed publication schedule but averages two issues per year, with the size of each issue depending on the amount of material to be reported. It always has one or two articles of a scholarly nature, generally written by a member of the Society. No comprehensive index existed and it was difficult to locate a desired article. The major historical libraries in the state have at least partial collections of back issues.

Three indices have been prepared that should ease the difficulty of locating an article. The first is a chronological listing of all titles together with the author(s); the second is a listing of author's names and the issues in which the individual published. A keyword index is the third section and will aid in locating topic when the original title has been forgotten. A user is cautioned that authorship of some articles is indicated only by initials and some have no author indicated. No attempt was made to identify or alter initials.

This is the first attempt at indexing *La Crónica* and the compilers judgment was used to select the keywords. Also, users may locate errors in omissions spelling, location, etc. The use of the web format allows corrections to be entered without significant difficulty and you are asked to submit corrections and suggestions via the Historic Society's email address, hsnminfo@ptd.net. If the index proves a valuable asset future issue of *La Crónica* will be added, probably every two years.
